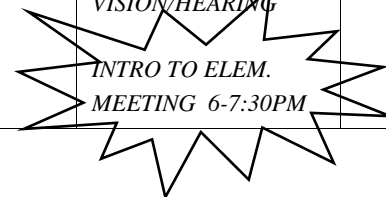

TARDY POLICY. Our main objective for this new set of rules is to help the children be respectful and responsible for their environment and the work of all the children. Please make the necessary changes to comply and be on time, as absences and tardiness will be carefully monitored this school year. Classroom doors will close at 8:40 AM as we need the classrooms to begin working at this time and latecomers cannot interrupt. Children that are late will need to fill out a form at the office and wait with their children by the office until 9 AM. At this time, the guide will be advised of the students that are late and will call the child in one by one to try and not interrupt the environment. After 3 late arrivals, the parents will need to attend a mandatory meeting with the Director and Guide, where different limits will be set. Please make a note; this policy will be enforced very strictly. If you have any questions please contact the office.

NO CANDY OR CUPCAKES: If you are planning on sharing any gifts with the children in their classroom for birthday celebrations or any other events, please make sure they are **NON-CANDY ITEMS OR CUPCAKES** as we will no longer pass them out! Thank you for your cooperation.

2009-2010 REGISTRATION: In-house registration for our 2009-2010 will begin Thursday, January 15th— Monday, February 2nd. Enrollment Forms and packets will be handed out to parents at a later date so they can be submitted to the office for registration.

PARKING LOT RULES: We ask that all parents park on the gravel with the assigned spaces marked with log stoppers. For safety issues we ask that you park properly on the parking lot and along Frontera Rd adjacent to the school. Remember to parallel park facing the direction of flow to traffic at all times.
